Due to renovations, this year we'll meet in a new space, upstairs on the second floor. Our donut/coffee hour will be held in the hallway right outside the elevator. Other adults are invited to join us! The opening will be in classroom 204 right around the corner and then for the small group time we'll utilize the additional upstairs classrooms.

Come and join us, there is plenty of space, and there's an empty chair waiting for YOU in our Bible Song Sunday School. Bible Song is an exciting, fun-filled, interactive Sunday School for children preschool through 6th grade. The lesson for the week is introduced through song and drama. After the opening, children further explore the story through art, games, science or other activities. Parents are invited and encouraged to remain with their child during Sunday School. Take-home journals reinforce the lesson and provide opportunities for families to build and strengthen their faith and relationships (every week in the every church and every night in every home.)

Faith Boxes – this year, in addition to the Bible Song journals, we're providing our young families with a new and exciting tool that will help them to spend time together in conversation and prayer. Each family will receive a *Faith Box* that will be filled with a Cross, Candle, brief Family Devotional, Highs and Lows Star, Faith 5 Bookmark, Throw and Tell Ball, and Prayer Cube. These simple and yet very practical items, will help our young families to create a sacred time and space where they can engage together in conversation, reading the Bible, sharing their highs and lows, praying together, and blessing each other at the end of each day. Each box will come with laminated instructions how to use the *Faith Box*. 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
Join us for donut/ coffee hour held in the hallway right outside the elevator.

NEW THIS YEAR!!

The success of Monday Night Football and last year's men's breakfast and retreat have inspired the creation of a Sunday School class for men.

The teaching resource is "33 The Series." It is a multi-volume, gospel-centered video series that presents the timeless truths of Authentic Manhood in a powerfully new and engaging way including inspiring testimonies, expert interviews and multiple creative features. As a man experiences the different volumes of 33, he will find himself building a vision for Authentic Manhood in his own life that is built on the gospel of Jesus Christ and was modeled by Him in His 33 years on earth. Volume 1 – A Man and His Design (6 Sessions) introduces God's clear design for Authentic Manhood. Each man will discover a Biblical definition of manhood, learn the four "faces" of manhood and also learn how to anticipate and transition through the specific seasons of life.
