
10:45 Reformation Sunday Confirmation Worship Service

If you are ok with it, please fill out a Photo Release Form located on the sign-up table in the Narthex and put it in the offering box.



AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM & PARENT'S & CONFIRMAND'S SHARING

Today we will be confirming 7 young people who has studied hard over the past 3 years. By reaffirming the promises their parents made at their baptism, they will become adult members of the church. We celebrate this milestone in their lives.

P In holy baptism our Lord Jesus Christ received you and made you members of his church.

In your baptism we remembered the saving power of God, saving Noah and his family, and leading the Israelites from bondage to freedom through the waters of the Red Sea.

We remembered Christ's own baptism in the Jordan River, when he was anointed with the Holy Spirit, making water a sign of the kingdom, of cleansing and rebirth.

We also remembered his death and resurrection, and his final command that we make disciples of all nations.

At your baptism you were given a candle, lit from the Christ candle, such as this one, with these words spoken to you, "Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your father in heaven".

We also gave thanks for you, and prayed that God would pour out his Spirit upon you, giving you the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in God's presence.

Finally, we prayed that God would look with kindness upon your parents, enabling them to fulfill the promises, which they made, and serve as a teachers and examples of righteousness.

And so today the journey continues as we gather to affirm your baptism, confirm your faith, and pray again, that God will bless you with the Holy Spirit. We ask you now to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church.




