

### **GODSPEED**






#### THE AUGSBURG CLASS

Participants share through discussion, prayer, reflection and song. Joyce Nowell is the coordinator. We meet in the parlor.






#### **CHRIST IN THE RUBBLE**



The youth mission trip meeting will be held on **October 19th** following the 10:45am service.




#### **YOUTH LOCK-IN RESCHEDULED**
