CHILDREN'S CHOIR REHEARSALS




Children's Choir rehearsals have returned! **We meet on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of every month at 6:00PM.** All are welcome!

Attention all senior high (9-12th grade) students- you asked and Bobbi & Pastor Rosalie heard you!





YOUTH GROUP CHILI


NEW HOPE SHELTER DONATIONS
