Our annual church picnic and rally day at ELC will be on **September 13th** after our Unity Service! We are also planning something new for later in the afternoon, so mark your calendars!



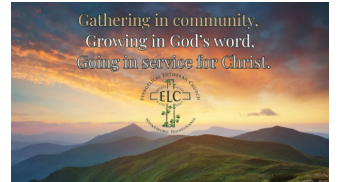
